OPEN EARS is an inter-denominational Christian Charitable Organisation providing fellowship and support for people who have impaired hearing, and anyone sympathetic to their special needs. Our main ministry is to deafened people who use hearing aids, lip-reading and other forms of communication and whose first language is spoken English, but we also attract and welcome British Sign Language users. All our events have Speech-to-Text and Loop, and we endeavour to provide sign-language interpreters at our in-person events.

Realising that Christians with impaired hearing miss out to some extent in their own churches, Open Ears aims to provide the following:

- Additional fellowship and Bible teaching online. We anticipate also holding some in-person events from 2024.

HISTORICAL Open Ears was founded (as the Hard of Hearing Christian Fellowship – HHCF) by a group of concerned Christians in London in 1974. The first Fellowship Weekend was held in 1977. and a national weekend or holiday took place every year until the Covid pandemic.

EVENTS A national weekend or holiday took place every year until the Covid pandemic, either as a weekend away or a Monday to Friday break. They were held at lovely hotels and Christian centres in different parts of the country, to encourage as many people to come as possible. We hope to hold more in person events from 2024; all events will be fully accessible to all those with a hearing loss, with induction loop and speech-to-text facilities provided, and BSL interpretation where possible.
