## Week 44

Date	Day	Subject	Prayer
30-Oct	Monday	Devotional	'Psalm 46:103: Be still and know that I am God.' Take time today to spend time with God and praise him for who he is. Spend time listening to him and what he wants to say to you.
31-Oct	Tuesday	World	Pray for those responsible for Social Care in the UK. Pray that high standards of care will be available to everyone who needs it.
01-Nov	Wednesday	Hearing Loss	Pray for new mothers and fathers of babies born deaf, that they will find the help and support they need.
02-Nov	Thursday	Open Ears	Give thanks for the vision and courage of the founders of HHCF/Open Ears and for its dedicated supporters over the years.
03-Nov	Friday	Family & Friends	Pray for those with no family or who have lost touch with their family. Pray for new people who care to be brought into their lives.

05-Nov	Sunday	Church	Pray for churches struggling financially, especially in rural areas, and for more funding for training new ministers.

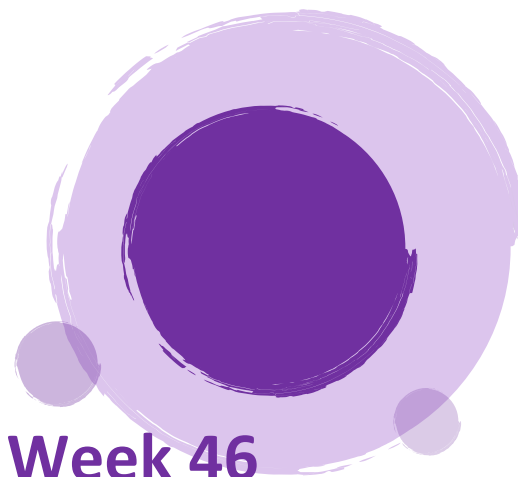

Date	Day	Subject	Prayer
06-Nov	Monday	Devotional	'1 John 1:9: If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins.' Is there anything we need to bring before God? What an encouragement to know that he will always be there for us and willing to forgive us.
07-Nov	Tuesday	Thanksgiving	Give thanks for those public services and utilities maintaining the infrastructure of the country every day.
08-Nov	Wednesday	Hearing Loss	Pray for new hearing technology to be developed or existing technology to be improved.
09-Nov	Thursday	Open Ears	Pray for Open Ears to reach out to young Deaf and hard of hearing people with the Gospel and grow its membership for the future.
10-Nov	Friday	Family & Friends	Pray for our wider families, especially if we do not see them regularly. Guide the younger members of our families with various aspects of their lives, e.g., school, college, work, hobbies, relationships etc.

Date	Day	Subject	Prayer
13-Nov	Monday	Devotional	'2 Thessalonians 3:16: May the Lord of peace Himself give you peace at all times.' May this be a prayer for all. What a comfort that if we rest in God's love, He will grant us peace.
14-Nov	Tuesday	Thanksgiving	Give thanks for the servicemen and women of the UK involved in conflict zones overseas and for their dedication and commitment to duty.
15-Nov	Wednesday	Hearing Loss	Pray for those from other countries who are Deaf/hard of hearing and are isolated by linguistic/cultural barriers here in the UK.

19-Nov	Sunday	Church	Pray for churches to be more aware of those with hidden disabilities, including hearing loss, and make them feel welcome and included.

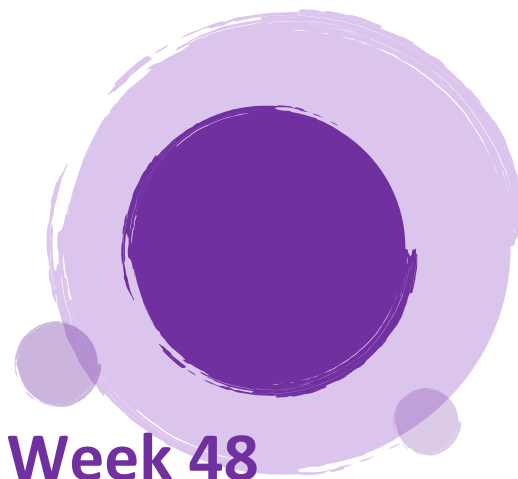

Date	Day	Subject	Prayer
20-Nov	Monday	Devotional	'Romans 12:18: As far as it depends on you, live at peace with everyone.' As we strive to be more Christ-like in our everyday lives, remember this verse in everything we do that we may be a shining light in this world as people observe our behaviour.
21-Nov	Tuesday	Thanksgiving	Give thanks for counsellors, advocates and therapists helping people to adjust to their loss of hearing and/or other faculties.
22-Nov	Wednesday	Hearing Loss	Pray for elderly hard of hearing people who may be struggling with their hearing and are feeling isolated as a result.
23-Nov	Thursday	Open Ears	Pray for Churchear, the European equivalent of Open Ears, and for Susanne Willdig who is on the Board of Churchear.

Date	Day	Subject	Prayer
27-Nov	Monday	Devotional	'John 10:10: I have come that they may have life and have it to the full.' Give thanks to God for the gift of His Son and what this means for us.
28-Nov	Tuesday	Thanksgiving	In America, 'Thanksgiving Day' is held at this time of year when families gather to share a thanksgiving meal together and give thanks for the harvest.
29-Nov	Wednesday	Hearing Loss	Pray for the provision of lip-reading classes in the UK to help those recently deafened to adjust to their new situation more easily.
30-Nov	Thursday	Open Ears	Give thanks for Hearing Eye, the magazine of Open Ears which has been produced quarterly for almost 50 years. Pray that HE will continue to reach the isolated and the lonely with the Good News of Jesus.
01-Dec	Friday	Family & Friends	Pray for those living with people who have an increasing loss of hearing. Pray that they will be able to access all the support they need, especially with the communication challenges that changing hearing will bring.
02-Dec	Saturday	World	Pray for Deaf Ministries International (DMI), based in Australia who work with Deaf people in developing countries including several in Africa and the Philippines. 03-Dec	Sunday	Church	Pray for Churches to include both children and adults with hearing loss, in activities in the run-up to Christmas.

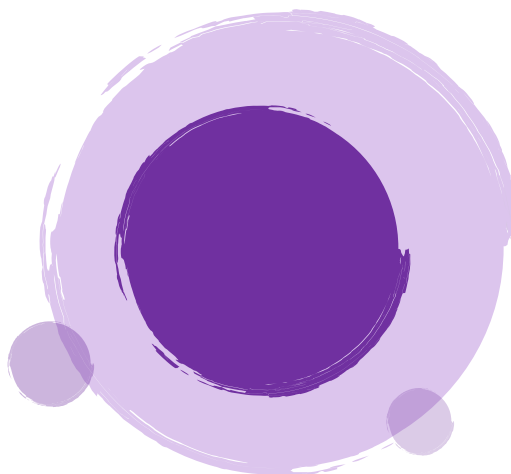

Date	Day	Subject	Prayer
04-Dec	Monday	Devotional	'Isaiah 64:8: We are the clay, You are the potter; we are all the work of Your hand.' Help us to follow Your will for our lives because You know what is best for us.
05-Dec	Tuesday	Thanksgiving	Give thanks for charities, both local and national, which support people with hearing loss.
06-Dec	Wednesday	Hearing Loss	Pray for Social Services departments as they support those with hearing loss. Pray that they will have the staff and the financial means to provide all the help needed.
07-Dec	Thursday	Open Ears	Pray for Susanne Willdig as she provides Speech to Text support for our meetings and conferences.
08-Dec	Friday	Family & Friends	Pray that organisations supporting those with hearing loss may also have an understanding of the needs of, and be able to help, the people living alongside them

Date	Day	Subject	Prayer
11-Dec	Monday	Devotional	'1 Thessalonians 4:17: And so we will be with the Lord forever.' What a wonderful promise to look forward to!
12-Dec	Tuesday	Thanksgiving	Give thanks for all teaching and ancillary staff who have dedicated their professional lives to helping children with hearing loss.

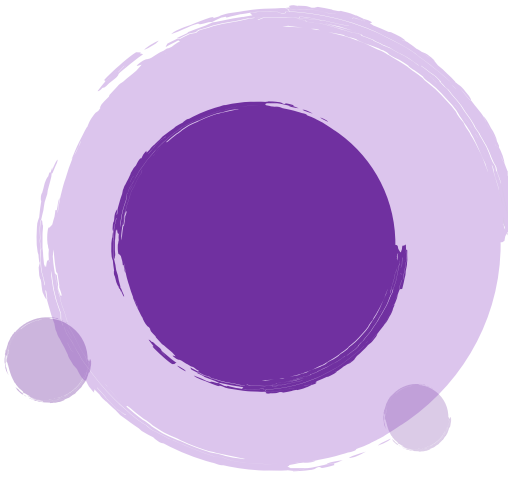
